

LEARN TO QUILT!

Basic Quilting: On the Double with Borders

This beginner's course offers basic instruction on rotary cutting and accurate piecing while making a simple lap quilt. Week 1 is all about rotary cutting and true ¼" seam allowance. Week 2 is focused on sewing block rows together. Week 3 covers borders. We offer a separate binding class 2 weeks following to allow participants to have their project long-arm quilted if they choose, before binding class.

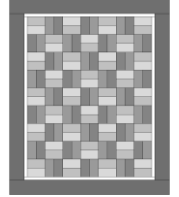
Mondays June 12, 19, 26 6-9pm

Cost: \$45 + pattern

Binding Class

This class will cover both hand and machine binding techniques for a perfect finish to your quilt.

Thursday, June 8 OR Thursday, July 13 OR Thursday, August 17 6-9pm

Cost: \$15

Have a quilted project ready to bind, bring binding fabric (not cut)

Traditional Sampler Blocks

In this class we will make six sampler blocks and learn to use the Easy Angle and Companion Angle tools. Students will receive in depth instruction that will provide skills to build a great foundation for future projects. The first 3 classes teach 6 different blocks and the fourth class will teach sashing and border application. Students should have basic knowledge of rotary cutting and ¼" seams.

Cost: \$55 + pattern

Pattern, rulers and supplies are available separately.
