


# GENTLE BREEZE

### Yardage

Background	2 1/8 yards
Yellow	7/8 yard
Green	1/8 yard
Blue (same as border)	7/8 yard
Border and binding	1 3/4 yards
Backing	4 1/3 yards or 2 1/4 yards minky


**Also needed:** 2.0 Thangle papers

A simple and graceful block made from fabrics to remind us of a gentle summer breeze.  
Made using Thangles™ papers, the half square triangles are also a breeze!



Cream	2 - 4 1/2" x wof	12 - 4 1/2" squares	A
	13 - 2 1/2" x wof	48 - 2 1/2" squares	G
		96 - 2 1/2" squares	H
		16 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Thangle strips	F
	2 - 12 1/2" x wof	31 - 2" x 12 1/2" rectangles	Sashing
Yellow	8 - 2 1/2" x wof	48 - 2 1/2" squares	B
		48 - 2 1/2" squares	D
		16 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Thangle strips	E
Green	1 - 2" x wof	20 - 2" squares	Cornerstones
Blue	6 - 4 1/2" x wof	48 - 4 1/2" squares	C
Border	4 - 6" x length of fabric	Set aside for borders	Outer border
	4 - 2 1/2" x length of fabric	Join into one long strip for binding	Binding

1. Place a cream and yellow 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Thangle strip right sides together, with yellow on bottom. Center Thangle paper on top with raw edges even with sides of strips. Sew on all dashed lines using a 2.0 stitch length. Cut apart on all solid lines to yield 6 half square triangles. Press to yellow and remove paper. Repeat with all 16 cream and yellow strips to get a total of 96 half square triangles to measure 2 1/2".


2. Sew Step 1 units, 2 1/2" (G) cream squares and 2 1/2" (D) yellow squares into 4 patch units as pictured. Make 48 to measure 4 1/2".



3. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 48 cream 2 ½” squares (H). Place a cream square on one corner of blue 4 ½” (C) square as pictured. Sew on drawn line. Press toward corner and trim away bottom 2 layers. Place a second H square onto adjacent corner. Stitch on drawn line, press and trim. Unit should measure 4 ½”. Make 48.




4. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side 48 yellow 2 ½” squares (B). Place yellow square on one corner of cream 4 ½” (A) square as pictured. Sew on drawn line. Press toward corner and trim away bottom 2 layers. Place a second B square onto opposite corner. Stitch on drawn line, press and trim. Repeat with remaining 2 corners. Unit should measure 4 ½”. Make 12.



5. Assemble Step 2 & 3 units into a row as pictured. Make 24.

6. Assemble Step 3 & 4 units into a row as pictured. Make 12




Step 5: Make 24



Step 6: Make 12


7. Assemble rows into blocks. Make 12 blocks to measure 12 ½”.



8. Make 5 sashing rows as pictured, using 3 - 2" x 12 1/2" cream rectangles and 4 - 2" green squares.



9. Sew blocks into 4 rows, placing remaining sashing strips on each end and between blocks as pictured.



10. Join block rows and sashing rows into quilt center to measure 42 1/2" x 56".

11. Add borders, sides first then top and bottom. Press toward borders.

Layer, quilt and bind.
